This Week:

To help support you at home and to spark conversations about learning, here is what the children have been covering this week.

	English	Mathematics
Reception	This week we have been looking at the book 'Santasaurus'. I lost the labels to my Christmas list and so the children helped me to write the labels using the sounds that we have learnt this half term.	In Maths, we have been learning about the numbers to 10. We represented numbers using Christmas pictures, extending this by thinking about how many was one more and one less than a given number.
Year 1	This week we have continued with our Design and Technology project and we have gone on to make a sea picture with a moving lever. The children have come up with their own idea for a Christmas moving picture and have written and drawn a plan for it. We have been practising how to spell the common words: 'one', 'out' and 'children'.	Between play rehearsals and Technology we have managed to order numbers to 20 and also name and recognise 2D shapes. We had fun following a colour code on a picture of mixed shapes. We have practised counting back from ten and trying to make our fingers keep up with our counting!
Year 2	We wrote lovely Christmas acrostic poems and have also practised joined-up handwriting. We have worked on spotting those "tricky words" which are difficult to spell. A list of these is coming home for Christmas!	This week in year 2 we have become very skilled at learning some multiplication facts. We can "skip count" on our fingers and can solve some word problems involving groups of things.
Year 3	In English this week we have continued to enjoy The Twits and learn about the conventions of writing dialogue. We have been comparing the story version of The Twits to the playscript version and the children have done a great job of getting into character to perform the playscript! We are focussing on homophones and common exception words. All children should be confident in the correct usage of your and you're, there, their and they're and our and are.	In maths, the children have spotted how useful the 4 times table can be when working out the 8 times table (ie. doubling or halving). They are able to explain why dividing by a bigger number gives you a smaller answer (when there are more things to share out equally, you get less each). By the end of December, we expect all children to be fluent in their 2, 3, 5 and 10 times tables, in and out of order.
Year 4	This week in English, the children have been completing their playscripts, editing and publishing them. They included stage directions and worked hard to tell the story through the character's actions as well as their words.	The children have been working hard in maths this week, with a particular focus on the 6 and 9 times tables. They have been working to draw links between them and link maths facts together.
