

CLL – Communication, Language and Literacy

- Children will begin to develop their listening and attention skills by taking part in small group, whole class and whole school activities.
- They will listen carefully to others in their play, circle time activities, show and tell and even when following recipes to make delicious hedgehog bread and Christmas biscuits.
- The children will give meaning to the different marks that they make, and through our daily phonics sessions they will also learn the basic sounds and will begin to write them using clearly formed letters.



PD – Physical Development

- Children will develop gross motor skills by experimenting with different ways of moving, jumping, walking and running.
- Children will develop their fine motor skills by using simple tools to effect changes to materials and in our daily funky finger activities. They will also begin to develop the lines needed to form recognisable letters.
- Children will develop good practices with regard to self-care, hygiene, eating and exercising.




PSED – Personal, Social and Emotional Development

- The children will begin to understand what it means to be a part of Hampreston School. They will explore their feelings in a safe and nurturing environment that will allow their self-confidence to bloom.
- They will explore what makes them special and think about how other people are different to us but still special too.
- Children will begin to manage their own feelings and behaviour in a healthy and appropriate way.
- They will look at our bed time routines and how they can affect our mental well-being.
- The children will develop positive friendships and relationships in our class and at playtimes with the Year 1 and 2 children.

M – Mathematics

- The children will learn to count reliably to 5 and recognise the numerals 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5. They will begin to recognise different representations of numbers up to 5 and to understand that even if the order or arrangement changes, the number stays the same.
- They will have the opportunity to sort objects into two groups based on size, colour and shape. They will discover that collections can be sorted in a number of ways and into more than two groups
- The children will also be sequencing activities and events in their day as a first experience and sense of time.



UW- Understanding the World

- The children will explore what makes them special and what makes the people in our lives special too.
- They will look at different role models and think about how we can be better role models to others.
- They will explore Hampreston Church and think about why it is a special place, especially in the build up to Christmas.
- The children will learn about Harvest, Bonfire Night, Remembrance Day, Diwali, Advent and Christmas
- The children will begin to use simple software on computers.

EAD – Expressive Arts and Design

Children will have many opportunities to explore their creativity by:

- Exploring and using different instruments
- Singing songs, listening and responding to music
- Using and combining different media
- Constructing using different materials
- Creating Autumnal crafts, Fireworks, Poppies, Diwali tea light holders and Christmas Crafts

Children will also be encouraged to use their imagination to begin to introduce storylines into their creative play.
